

# History of the Golden State Derby



Stakes Record: 400 Yards, :19.30, One Famous Eagle (2008); 440 Yards, :21.39, Tolltac (1984)

Most Wins By A Jockey: 3, Kenneth Hart, Steve Treasure & John Ward

Most Wins By A Trainer: 3, Bruce Hawkinson

Golden State Derby Highlights: 1975, Easy Date, victorious in the 1974 All American Futurity, establishes a new stakes record of :21.64 under jockey Donald Knight. 1983, Shirley B Gayle captures the richest ever Golden State Derby of \$531,500 while providing jockey Steve Treasure with his second consecutive Golden State Derby triumph. 1984, Tolltac set a stakes record of :21.39 while giving jockey John Ward his third Golden State Derby victory. 1985, Eastex becomes the second All American Futurity winner to capture this event. 1988, Dashing Val's victory marks the third Golden State Derby win for jockey Kenneth Hart, trainer Bruce Hawkinson and owner Edward C. Allred. 1992, Holland Ease ends his runner-up jinx with a nose victory over favored Femmes Frolic. 1994, Time For Royal Cash becomes the first horse since Tolltac (1983-84) to sweep the Golden State Futurity and Derby. It is the first victory in this race for trainer Tom Bazley. 1995, Ah Sigh, who had an automatic berth to the Champion Of Champions, opts to run in the Golden State Derby instead. This win caps off her Champion 3-Year-Old Filly season. Ah Sigh is another who has captured both the Golden State Futurity and Derby. 1996, Templetonian becomes the third consecutive winner of the Golden State Futurity and Derby as trainer Blane Schvaneveldt and jockey Roman Figueroa each win their first Golden State Derby. 1998, Girl Secrets wins her third stakes of the year in the Golden State Derby, defeating Champion 2-Year-Old Filly Corona Cash. The Golden State Derby win is the fourth for owner Edward C. Allred, but the first for jockey Joe Badilla and trainer Kelly Long. It is also the first Golden State Derby to be contested at 400 yards. 2000, Jockey Henry Garcia called an end to his outstanding riding career after piloting Separatist to victory in the Golden State Derby. 2001, Royal Dip posted a nose decision in the Golden State Derby, beating a stellar field that included Champion Dashing Knud, Make It Anywhere, Blue Grass Bounce and Bridlewood. 2002, Sired by the outstanding Thoroughbred Hennessy, Check Him Out broke cleanly and quickly from post position two to defeat A Tac First by three-quarters of a length. 2003, Ridden by Alvin Brossette for trainer Donna McArthur, Mr Pie Chick upset fastest qualifier Special Queen Sa by 3/4 lengths. It was the owners first Grade 1 stakes win ever. 2005, Diller A Dollar won as the longest shot in the field at 47-1. 2007, Eventual World Champion Blues Girl Too defeated Sir Runaway Dash by a nose to claim the richest running of the Golden State Derby since 1989. 2008, Eventual champion One Famous Eagle won his first of two Grade 1 derbies of the meeting by defeating Stylish Jess Br. 2009, The filly Alice K White defeated an outstanding field that included champion Foose, millionaire Tres Passes and Louisiana Senator.

## Grade 2 - \$125,000 - October 5, 2007

Stakes Record: 400 Yards, :19.38, Ocean Runaway (2005)

Most Wins By A Jockey: 4, Joe Badilla Most Wins By A Trainer: 3, Blane Schvaneveldt

PCQHRA Breeders Derby Highlights: 1988, Easygo Effort, victorious in the \$495,081 Golden State Futurity in 1987, provides jockey Kip Didericksen with his second win in this race. 1991, Jockey Roman Figueroa and trainer Blane Schvaneveldt combine for their second PCQHRA Breeders Derby win when Wellinformed sizzles to a :19.79 clocking. 1992, At odds of 40-1, Elie Rey Beduino sets the stakes standard of :19.69 in capturing the third and final PCQHRA Breeders Derby to be run at Hollywood Park. 1994, Daily Triple wins his second Derby of the season and gives trainer Brian Koriner his second victory in this event. 1995, Dicey Secret avenges a loss in the trials by digging in during the finals to post her third stakes win of the season. 1996, Air Beduino gives jockey Eddie Garcia and trainer Connie Hall each their first PCQHRA Breeders Derby win. 1997, Special Mongoose wins the PCQHRA Breeders Derby for owner Tom McEwen, who is a legend in the drag racing industry. 1998, Hitarun wins the Derby to help trainer Paul Jones win his first quarter horse training title at Los Alamitos. His 155 wins during the 1998 meet is a record for the most wins during a single season. 1999, Dash To Chivato, at 47-1, was a surprise winner of the PCQHRA Breeders Derby, giving leading California breeder Vessels Stallion Farm their first victory in this event. 2000, Separatist claimed his third derby of the year while holding off Chicks First Policy to win the PCQHRA Breeders Derby in stakes record time. 2001, Make It Anywhere, a half-brother to 2000 PCQHRA Breeders Derby winner Separatist, became only the second horse to sweep the PCQHRA Futurity and Derby series with his 3/4-length score in the Derby. Jockey Joe Badilla has now won the last three runnings of this event. 2002, Sent off as the 8-5 co-favorite, Check Him Out outlasted the quick breaking Miami Cartel while setting a stakes record in the PCQHRA Breeders Derby. 2003, Stel Corona spoiled Valiantly's bid for a PCQHRA Breeders Series sweep thanks to a superior break and powerful finish in the \$107,000 Breeders Derby. 2004, Hawkish became just the third horse to sweep both the PCQHRA futurity and derby. 2005, After running at Ruidoso Downs for the first half of the year, Ocean Runaway made a victorious return to the track on the way to earning champion 3-year-old colt honors.

## Grade 1 - \$484,000 - October 6, 2007

Stakes Record: 350 Yards, :17.29, Hawkish (2003)

Most Wins By A Jockey: 4, Kip Didericksen Most Wins By A Trainer: 6, Blane Schvaneveldt

PCQHRA Breeders Futurity Highlights: 1983, Major Grade 1 winner Indigo Illusion sets a stakes record of :17.46 in providing trainer Bruce Jackson with his second consecutive futurity win. 1989, Trainer Bob Baffert wins his third consecutive futurity when Streakin Jewel scores in :17.70. 1991, Deeachick, claimed for \$6,250 earlier in the meet, captures the PCQHRA Breeders Futurity, giving Blane Schvaneveldt his third win in this event as a trainer and his first as an owner. 1992, Trainer Blane Schvaneveldt wins his fourth PCQHRA Breeders Futurity when Smooth Movin Gal provides Kip Didericksen with his third win in this event. 1994, BCR Town Jewel romps over eight rivals, giving trainer Blane Schvaneveldt his fifth victory in this event. BCR Town Jewel's sire, Streakin Jewel, won this race in 1989. 1995, Magnificent Effort, the quickest qualifier, is sent off at odds of more than 6-1 and wins easily. Trainer Blane Schvaneveldt earns his sixth win in this event and jockey Kip Didericksen garners his fourth. 1998, Bono Jazz sets a stakes record by winning the PCQHRA Breeders Futurity in :17.39. Jockey Dusty Stimpson has now ridden the winners with two of the three fastest times in this race. 1999, SV Blue Tornado is disqualified from first, giving D.Wayne Lukas the win with the filly Worth A Look. This is the first quarter horse stakes win in 20 years for Lukas, a leading Thoroughbred trainer who originally got his start in quarter horse racing. 2000, Make It Anywhere beat Bridlewood in a battle of the top two sellers from the 1999 Pacific Coast Sale. Make It Anywhere also became the 1,000th Quarter Horse to win a stakes race at Los Alamitos. 2001, Jaime Gomez saddled the first and second-place finishers of the PCQHRA Breeders Futurity when Sassy Smith outdueled stablemate Babe Watcher. 2002, The richest running of the PCQHRA Breeders Futurity up to that year produced the biggest upset in the event's 21-year history following 46-1 longshot Valiantly's half-length victory over Deefirst. 2003, Hawkish blew away the stakes record - lowering the bar by more than 1/10th of a second. 2004, trainer Jaime Gomez won the race for the third time in five years. 2005, Finding Nemo pulled away from the field by 1 1/4 lengths to win the biggest purse in the race's history.

Golden State Futurity Highlights: 1970, In Vogue scores a 61-1 upset while beating Tru Try by half a length under jockey Kenneth Hart. 1977, Easy Della Jet scores the fastest 350-yard running of this race, winning in :17.70 under jockey Danny Cardoza. 1979, Merridoc, one of the sport's top sires scores his second Grade I win while providing jockey Terry Lipham with his third Golden State triumph. 1985, Chingaderos wins the richest running of this race taking the \$673,991 running under jockey Bobby Don Harmon. 1990, Jacks Dash wins his second futurity in less than one month, setting the 400-yard standard of :19.67. 1993, Jockey Steve Treasure wins his fifth Golden State Futurity when guiding heavily favored Time For Royal Cash to victory. 1994, Ah Sigh completes her 2-year-old championship season with a strong win. 1995, Templetonian, guided by Roman Figueroa, defeats eventual Los Alamitos Million Futurity winner Evening Snow. Trainer Blane Schvaneveldt earns his fifth Golden State Futurity win. 1997, Artesias Specialchic scores his biggest win of the year in the Golden State Futurity, nosing out favored Twelvie at the wire. This win, coupled with a runner-up finish in the Los Alamitos Million, earns Artesias Specialchic the title of 1997 Champion 2-Year-Old Gelding. 1998, Trainer Jaime Gomez finishes first and second in the Golden State Futurity with Romeo Ryon and Pride Of Katella. The two horses were ridden by cousins Alex and Carlos Bautista, and are both owned by the Dutch Masters III partnership. Romeo Ryon was bred by Zory Kuzyk, who won the Golden State Futurity in 1992 with Check Her Twice. 2000, Dashing Knud outduels Kindergarten Futurity winner Secret Card by 1 1/4 lengths to win the second richest Quarter Horse race in California. 2001, All American Futurity runner-up Tres Seis won the Golden State Futurity to secure the title of Champion 2-Year-Old Colt. Owner Gwendolyn Eaves, trainer John Bassett and jockey Joe Badilla also won this race in 1999 with A Delightful Dasher. 2002, John Bassett won the Golden State Futurity for the third time in four years thanks to First Place Queen's hard-fought nose win over Sum Special Strawfly. 2003, Be A Bono gave legendary owner Spencer Childers his richest stakes win in his more than 50 years in the business. 2004, "Ocean Runaway is as good a horse as I've trained," said Dennis Ekins, who trained Tolltac, the champion 2-year-old and Golden State winner in 1983. 2005, "This is the greatest feeling in the world - to win the two biggest races of the year so far," said trainer Jaime Gomez, whose Higher Fire also captured the Ed Burke Million Futurity.

# History of the Los Alamitos Super Derby



## Grade 1 - \$700,000 - November 10, 2007

Stakes Record: 400 Yards, :19.36, Apollitical Time (2005), 440 Yards, :21.37, Zure Hope Again (1988)

Most Wins By A Jockey: 4, Jerry Nicodemus, Ramon Sanchez & Charles Smith Most Wins By A Trainer: 5, Blane Schvaneveldt

Los Alamitos Derby Highlights; 1965, Go Josie Go becomes the third consecutive Los Alamitos Derby winner to be named World Champion. 1968, Jockey Charles Smith captures his fourth derby in six years, guiding Truly Night to victory in the richest of the first 27 derbies. 1976, Dash For Cash gives trainer D.Wayne Lukas his second straight win in the Los Alamitos Derby. 1977, Jockey Jerry Nicodemus wins his third straight derby, piloting Azure Three to victory. 1978, Town Policy, "horsenapped" eight months earlier and found only two months before the race, gives trainer Blane Schvaneveldt "the most satisfying victory of my career." 1984, Dashes Dream, later to win the Champion Of Champions, looks sharp while Tolltac, the 4-5 favorite, is off the board for the first time in his career. 1987, First Down Dash becomes the ninth Los Alamitos Derby winner to earn world championship honors the same year. 1988, Zure Hope Again streaks to a stakes record time of :21.37. 1991, My Escalon appeared headed for an upset win before veering out sharply at the 1/16 pole when a rein broke. After disqualifying My Escalon from first to last, the stewards awarded the derby win to Frisco Flare, giving Schvaneveldt his fourth win in the race. 1996, Dashing Folly scores her ninth win in a row while earning an automatic berth to the Champion Of Champions. 1998, Corona Cash gives jockey Tami Purcell and trainer Donna McArthur their second Los Alamitos Derby win in the last three years. 1999, Old Habits becomes only the second horse to win the All American Derby and Los Alamitos Derby in the same year. Danny Cardoza, who won this race as a jockey in 1980 and 1984, trained Old Habits to the win. 2000, In the dream matchup pitting the three divisional 2-year-old champions from 1999, Champion Corona Kool beat Separatist and A Delightful Dasher in the Los Alamitos Derby. 2001, Marmet, at odds of 35-1, upset favored Whosleavingwho to win the Los Alamitos Derby. 2002, Owned by eventual AQHA Champion Trainer Paul Jones, James Azevedo and his father-in-law, Charles Boyles, Miami Cartel won the richest running ever of the Los Alamitos Derby. 2003, AB What A Runner posted her best California effort, as she defeated a group that included champion First To Flash in stakes record time in the 49th running of Los Alamitos Derby. 2004, Breaking from post five, Be A Bono covered the distance in a stakes-record time of :19.43 - 1/100ths of a second better than the previous mark set by AB What A Runner in 2003. 2005, Apollitical Time eclipsed the previous year's stakes record with a time of :19.36 in a 7-1 upset of champion Ocean Runaway.

Los Alamitos Million Futurity Highlights: 1995, The inaugural running of the Los Alamitos Million is a huge success. Nine trials were contested to determine the field of ten. Evening Snow dominates the final 200 yards of this race and draws off at will in the first running of this event. Evening Snow is the first quarter horse to race in two million-dollar races in the same season. He previously finished fifth in the All American Futurity at Ruidoso Downs. Gelded after the All American, Evening Snow came into his own for 1995 Champion Owner Abigail Kawanakoa. 1996, Corona Cartel earns \$422,000 for his Los Alamitos Million victory. Corona Cartel's earnings for the year total \$544,435, placing him second behind All American Futurity winner Streakin Flyer. 1997, After being purchased midway through the season by Jim and Marilyn Helzer and Partners, This Snow Is Royal romps to an easy win in the Los Alamitos Million Futurity. His clocking of :19.67 is the quickest running of this event. The unpredictable colt would be named Champion 2-Year-Old Colt of 1997, having also competed in the All American Futurity. 1998, Riding Kingman Kid, Joe Badilla becomes the first two-time winner of the Los Alamitos Million, having also piloted 1995 winner Evening Snow. Kingman Kid recovered from mid-year surgery to win the Million at odds of 17-1, giving trainer Kelly Long her biggest victory during her first year of handling Ed Allred's stable. Allred was later named Champion Owner and Breeder of 1998. 1999, Eventual Champion 2-Year-Old Filly Corona Kool outduels Separatist to win the fifth renewal of the Los Alamitos Million, making Donna McArthur the first trainer to win the race twice. 2000, Dashing Knud finishes the year with an eight-race win streak in the richest race ever held in the 50-year history of Los Alamitos Race Course. 2001, The Vessels Stallion Farm team racks up back-to-back Los Alamitos Million scores thanks to Your First Moon's runaway victory in the 400-yard event. 2002, Purchased for \$23,500 at Ruidoso Yearling Sale, First Place Queen outdueled favorite Meteoric by a half length to win the richest race in the 52-year history of Los Alamitos. 2003, A Regal Choice was place first after Corona For Me was disqualified for interference. 2004, Ocean Runaway clinched the title of champion 2-year-old after setting his third stakes record of the year. 2005, 10-1 longshot Value The Man upset Higher Fire's chances of capturing the Los Alamitos Bonanza. 2006, The first running ever of the Los Alamitos Two Million Futurity was a great clash between eventual divisional champions Blues Girl Too and FDD Dynasty. All American Futurity winner No Secrets Here ran third and champion Jess You And I was fourth.

Champion Of Champions Highlights: 1972, Mr Jet Moore edges Kaweah Bar and Charger Bar to capture the inaugural running of the Champion Of Champions. 1976, Dash For Cash sets the track record with his :21.17-second victory. The winning margin of 1 3/4 lengths is one of the biggest margins of victory in this race. 1977, Dash For Cash becomes the only two-time winner of the race. 1979, The former claimer Mr Doty Bars pulls off the biggest upset in the Champion Of Champions when he earns the victory at 22-1. 1981, Denim N Diamonds defeats arch rival Sgt Pepper Feature. 1982, Sgt Pepper Feature captures the race, nosing out longshot My Startime, with Denim N Diamonds finishing third in her final career start. 1985, Cash Rate captures the race in :21.31 seconds. 1990, Dash For Speed wins to give jockey Kip Didericksen his first Champion Of Champions win. 1992, Jockey Kip Didericksen who earlier in the month had retired, returns to guide the 4-5 favorite Refrigerator to victory. 1993, Refrigerator becomes quarter horse racing's all-time leading earner by winning his second consecutive Champion Of Champions. Refrigerator also becomes just the second horse to ever win back-to-back Champion Of Champions while earning his second straight world champion title. 1994, Making his fourth start in this event, Refrigerator wins his record third consecutive Champion Of Champions. Jockey Bruce Pilkenton picks up his fourth win. 1995, My Debut wins his fifth straight race at Los Alamitos on his way to being named Champion Aged Horse/Gelding. My Debut gives trainer Blane Schvaneveldt his ninth Champion Of Champions win. Refrigerator, in his fifth Champion Of Champions, finishes eighth in what would be his final start. 1996, Dashing Folly finishes the 1996 racing season undefeated and later becomes the 16th Champion of Champions winner to be named World Champion Quarter Horse. 1997, SLM Big Daddy solidifies World Champion honors with a powerful win. Aided by a sealed track and a slight tailwind SLM Big Daddy's :21.20 clocking is the second fastest Champion Of Champions of all time and the fastest ever under the lights. 1998, SLM Big Daddy becomes only the third horse to ever win back-to-back runnings of the Champion Of Champions, earning his second straight World Champion title in the process. 2000, A Ransom led every step of the way to become the first Champion of Champions winner to go undefeated for the year since World Champion Dashing Folly in 1996. 2001, Tailor Fit upset reigning World Champion A Ransom to win the 30th renewal of the Champion of Champions. Tailor Fit is only the fourth horse to win the prestigious Champion of Champions more than once. 2002, Whosleavingwho posted the third fastest time ever in the history of the Champion of Champions while defeating a powerful field that included eventual Co-World Champion Streakin Sin Tacha, A Ransom and Corona Kool. 2003, The Down Side posted the second fastest winning time in the Champion of Champions. 2004, Cash For Kas edged eventual World Champion Be A Bono to win the Champion of Champions. Paul Jones picked up his third straight win in this race, each with a different horse. 2005, Ocean Runaway broke a 15-year-old track record at 400 yards in winning the Z. Wayne Griffin Director's Trials in :19.30 and then won the Champion of Champions three weeks later. 2006, Ocean Runaway's younger brother, Wave Carver, edged Be A Bono by a nose in a near-record clocking of :21.18.

First Down Runner won the 2005 Southern California Derby.

Stakes Record: 400 Yards, :19.40, Agouti; 440 Yards, :21.57, Kid O Dash

Most Wins By A Jockey: 2, Record shared by five jockeys Most Wins By A Trainer: 4, Paul Jones

Southern California Derby Highlights: 1989, Floozie Finder provides trainer Barry Woodhouse with his richest win in the \$187,342 Derby. 1991, Connie Hall becomes the first of two consecutive female trainers to capture the Southern California Derby when Kid O Dash rolls to a 440-yard stakes record clocking of :21.57. 1992, In one of the biggest upsets in quarter horse racing history, 121-1 longshot Royal Trips stops Corona Chick's bid to become the first horse to win 14 consecutive races, posting a head decision under jockey Joe Meier. Corona Chick finishes second. This was the only time the race was held at Hollywood Park. 1994, Artesias Special Gal wins her second stakes race of the season and gives jockey Eddie Garcia his second riding victory in this event. 1995, Coast Express defeats eventual 1995 Champion 3-Year-Old Filly Ah Sigh by a nose, giving trainer Jaime Gomez and jockey G.R. Carter their first Southern California Derby victories. 1996, Western Heart holds off Temerity Wrangler and Reckless Roula, giving jockey Kenneth Hart his second win in this event and trainer Bob Gilbert his first. 1997, Showoff Alibi gives trainer Paul Jones his first Grade 1 stakes win. 1998, Strawflyin Buds ends his career with a flourish by scoring an upset victory in the Southern California Derby. Strawflyin Buds is sired by 1990 Southern California Derby winner Strawfly Special, and now follows his sire into the stallion ranks. 1999, Dash To Chivato proved his PCQHRA Derby win was no fluke, defeating fastest qualifier Meddlin In Money in the Southern California Derby. The colt was then retired to stud after earning the title of California Champion 3-Year-Old Colt. 2000, Tiny First Down waited until the final start of her 3-year-old year to earn her first stakes win in the \$131,250 Southern California Derby. 2001, Tiny First Effort, a full sister to 2000 winner Tiny First Down, gives trainer Donna McArthur and jockey Sam Thomson back-to-back Southern California Derby wins. The Southern California Derby was one of three 2001 stakes wins for Tiny First Effort, who was named Champion Three-Year-Old Filly. 2002, Owned and bred by Joe Bettencourt, Agouti set a stakes record while also posting the meet's fastest time at 400 yards. 2004, Champion Hawkish made the final start of his career a winning one with a victory in the Southern California Derby. 2005, Third time was the charm for First Down Runner, who was unable to qualify for two previous derby finals in 2005 but made it into the Southern California Derby finals and won at 20-1.

Marathon Handicap Highlights: 1975, Wheatland carries a stakes record 129 pounds to victory under jockey James Dreyer, defeating 1974 Marathon victor The Moonshiner. 1978, Thoroughbred star Darrel McHargue settles for second aboard Tex Oh as Yogi Barre, under jockey Robert Adair, carries 125 pounds to victory. 1980, Viking Anne stops Friar Bob's attempt at a repeat Marathon victory when establishing a then track record win of :44.88. 1984, Senator Sage, carrying 130 pounds, settles for second behind Manus Mark, victorious under Ralph Pauline and 127 pounds. 1989, Hilco Scamper becomes the first Thoroughbred to win the Marathon while piloted by Lute Proctor. 1990, Baychaino, under Carlos Aguilar, goes wire to wire while setting a stakes record win of :44.49. 1993, Griswold becomes the first back-to-back Marathon winner, giving jockey Henry Garcia and trainer Daryn Charlton their second wins in this race. 1993, Charles Treece becomes the first trainer to saddle three Marathon winners when Mr Diddy Wa Diddy upsets world champion Griswold, who faded to eighth. 1994, Better Than Never, later to be named Champion Distance Horse of 1994, puts in a furious rally to beat Stellar Trux and Griswold, giving trainer Blane Schvaneveldt his first victory in this event. 1995, Brotherly holds off the late charge of Rapid Champ to win by a nose, giving trainer Charles Treece his fourth win in this event. 1996, Sign It Super defeats the 1995 Marathon winner Brotherly by 2 1/2 lengths. Sign It Super would later be named Champion Distance Horse in a runoff vote. 1998, The former \$2,500 claimer Two Steppin Alibi uses a late charge to win the biggest race of his career by a nose. He would later be involved in a run-off for champion distance horse, losing by only a few votes to midwest star Windville. 2000, Sign Of Lanty carries a stakes-record tying 130 pounds to victory while joining Griswold and The Moonshiner as the only two-time winners of the Marathon. 2001, Sign Of Lanty becomes the first three-time winner of the Marathon Handicap with his six-length score in the distance event. The 7-year-old gelding was later named champion distance horse for the second consecutive year. 2002, Sign Of Lanty made a powerful claim for being the greatest distance horse ever after winning the nation's richest 870-yard race for the fourth straight year. 2003, The son of Grand Slam, Heros Call set a stakes record in the Marathon final. 2004, Prankster CF scores big in only his second start at 870 yards. 2005, After a third-place finish in 2004, Roto Rooster shipped in from Oklahoma to win in 2005, upsetting 3-5 favorite Lords Table.
