Race Analysis

Bahreeda - Fits race conditions nicely and rallied for fourth vs. prior \$2,500 third-place finisher Bertranimo in last outing. Two races back, he rallied nicely around rivals on the far turn when victorious at lower class level. Three-time has solid distance rider up.

Swiss Twist - Was far back throughout in last needed outing when making first start in eight months. He beat eventual \$2,500 winner Sammy's Jammies for lone victory when setting a slow pace three outs ago.

Savona Victor - Competed in productive race at this class level in last outing when facing eventual \$2,500 winners Betranimo and Balius. He was third vs. eventual \$5,000 winner Excessive Danger after breaking very slow two races back. He was third vs. recent \$2,500 runnerup Wings Of Courage four outs back.

Eastern Wind - Is much better than last indicates and returns to winning class level. Two races back, he battled outside one rival for lead to the 1/4-pole and drew away nicely around the far turn while beating recent \$2,000 winner Manton. Gelding gets a seven-pound apprentice allowance here and looms one to catch in this fairly paceless field.

Flashy Boy - Came extremely wide into the stretch and showed run late in last better-than-looked try vs. recent \$2,500 fourth-place finisher Bahreeda. He was reclaimed by trainer who saddled him for \$5,000 claiming win at Fairplex Park 10 outs ago.

Razzle Dazzle Me - Beat an easier field in last narrow victory over prior maiden \$2,500 winner Alyjam. He was far back in prior five local outings but flashed solid improvement in second start for this trainer when victorious in last start.

Shakobe - Readily faded past a quick 21.65 opening quarter fraction in last well-beaten outing. He was no match vs. rival Eastern Wind in prior fourth-place try at this level when competing vs. third-place finisher who since won for \$2,000.

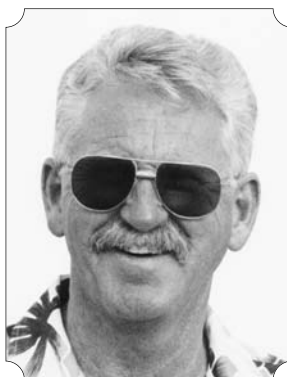

Race Analysis

Hug Maggi - Never threatened at higher class level in last start more than one month ago when competing vs. recent \$2,500 winner Brishane. Gelding has displayed much early speed at longer distances and defeated eventual 4 1/2-furlong \$2,500 winner Piedra Dancer three races back. He must contend with quarter horse speedster Dapper Dasher for the early lead here.

Savannahs Night - Is on the improve and was third vs. 2006 local \$10,000 winner First For The Money in last outing. Two races back, he was third vs. eventual \$4,000 third-place finisher El Marichi and can gain early prominence from this favorable post. He won at higher level here six outs ago.

Flicker Tape - Tries this distance for the first time and maiden dropped nose photo at 300 yards three outs ago when competing vs. eventual 300-yard maiden \$2,500 runnerup Planting Czech.

One Step Away - Returns in seven nights after setting the pace at longer distance in last outing vs. stretch-running winner who had previously finished fourth for \$2,000. He was third vs. repeat \$2,000 winner Vibod three outs ago.

C R Paracount - Shortens up in distance tonight after pressing the pace through a 21.65 opening quarter in last needed outing when making first start in five months. He tired to fourth at Bay Meadows four races back when facing eventual local \$5,000 third-place finisher One Of A Kind.

Dapper Dasher - Looms elusive target tonight and scored handy win at this distance three races back when catching a paceless field. Four races back, he broke slow and was caught behind horses down the backstretch. Gelding is in sharp form and appears the speedier of the two quarter horses in this field.

Talking To John - Makes first start in three months and won over the 5/8-mile Fairplex oval four outs ago. Gelding has plenty of past class and recorded the fastest of seven 3-furlong thoroughbred drills on March 31. He is formerly trained by Mark Glatt.

Race Analysis

Katkin - Needed last outing when making first start in nine months while non-threatening fourth vs. earlier 2007 Drinkers Of The Wind Derby sixth-place finisher Ces Bon. He won at this distance around one turn over the one-mile Delaware oval six outs ago and tries a two-turn race for the first time tonight.

Hes The Most - Was strong second in fast race at this distance in last start one month ago when competing vs. four-time lifetime winner War Silks. Two outs ago, he was caught very wide entering the first turn and remained wide down the backstretch. He was second vs. eventual daylight 4 1/2-furlong allowance winner Roulette FPA three outs ago.

Cool Sand Luke - Showed plenty of potential in troubled debut win 18 nights ago when awaiting room along the inside entering the stretch before angling around the leaders while winning in the final strides. Well-bred colt is out of mare who dropped multiple winner Roulette FPA. He is the lone three year old in this field and lack of seasoning is main concern.

Ces Bon - Tracked pacesetter to the 1/4-pole and opened up while well in hand when impressive winner at shorter distance in last when geared down nearing the wire. He has proven himself around two turns and was unlucky to lose four races back when ducking out briefly entering the stretch.

Eisus - Has been far back at this distance in last pair but ran some solid races last year when finishing second in 33 percent of his 15 starts. He was well-beaten second three outs ago vs. eventual allowance/optional claiming runnerup Hes The Most, one of his foes here.

Flame Game - Has been fourth or better while well beaten in last three local starts. He finished 11 lengths behind rival Hes The Most in last start and has achieved his best results on the Northern California Fair Circuit around one turn over the one-mile ovals.

Extended Leave - Set the pace when second at this distance vs. maiden rivals for lone win five outs ago. He lacked racing room past the 1/8-pole before finishing fairly well for fourth four races back vs. eventual allowance runnerup Hes The Most, one of his foes here.

Race Analysis

Mugleon - Was well clear of the third horse in last solid runnerup try vs. quick-breaking winner who was posting his fifth lifetime victory. Two outs ago, he didn't break alertly and drifted inward to run near the rail when sixth vs. stronger from this post. He is capable of quick start.

Pepe Splash - Makes first start in two months and has high-percentage rider up. He has been sparingly raced the past two years but was game third locally three outs ago when facing recent \$2,000 winner Classic Turbo.

Red Hot Alamos Bar - Broke very slow in last to ignore. Two races back, he veered inward to get bumped soon after the start before finishing with a nice stride while third vs. recent \$3,200 winner Fsixteen. He makes third start of his comeback and looms dangerous with an alert start.

Cattos Cocktail - Veered out to bump rival leaving the gate in last fourth-place try vs. own sex. She was fourth vs. recent \$6,250 daylight distaff claiming winner Cly Corona two races back and has been third or better in five of her 11 starts. She retains meet's leading quarter horse rider.

Capitan Tequila - Broke slow in last start and was fifth two races back vs. recent \$6,250 third-place finisher DS Okey. He is the lone sophomore in this field of older runners and is capable of quick start. Gelding beat recent \$4,000 runnerup Happy Camp Julie four outs ago.

The Right Suspect - Has improved in last pair and gets a positive post switch. He was only a head behind recent \$2,000 winner Classic Turbo in last fourth-place showing and was fourth vs. eventual \$3,200 runnerup Elegant Boots two races back.

Muggle Magic - Makes first start in 18 months and was second two races back vs. eventual 2006 local \$5,000 winner Fits The Bill. He faced prior 2005 local \$2,500 winner Beat Up in last fourth-place showing. Gelding is formerly trained by Antonio Soto.

Race Analysis

SURREAL CS - Made an uncontested early lead and was never pressured in last game win at this route over repeat allowance runnerup Starlit Jetalinah while covering her final 1/8 in moderate 15.32. She beat eventual 4 1/2-furlong allowance winner Rustic two outs ago and looms elusive target again.

STARLIT JETALINAH - Looms the primary speed threat for rival Surreal CS and has run three consecutive solid races under this rider. She couldn't contain two-time 2006 Texas stakes winner Dancers First Luv in the closing strides at shorter distance in last and was no match vs. rival Surreal CS in prior runnerup try.

DANCERS FIRST LUV - Is much better suited at this distance and showed a terrific stride the final 1/8 of last powerful win at shorter distance when rallying wide to beat prior allowance runnerup Starlit Jetalinah. Talented mare won two stakes races in Texas last year and both wins came around two turn over the one-mile Retama Park oval. She beat eventual local 2007 stakes winner Sandytiki two races back.

RUSTIC - Had no early speed while saving ground in last strong victory at shorter distance when unleashing big rally along the inside the final 1/8 when beating eventual two-time allowance runnerup Starlit Jetalinah, one of her rivals here.

BETTI JOE - Has no early speed and faces tough task vs. this quality field that includes three past stakes winners in Surreal CS, Dancers First Luv and Rustic. She was showing run on the far outside at shorter distance two races back.

OOPSADAISY - Also has a tough task here. Mare should benefit by last fourth-place try when making first start in two months. She has failed to repeat sharp 2006 wins over the easier Northern California Fair Circuit.

Race Analysis

JUDYS BLURR - Came away slow while getting bumped steadily to the 1/8-pole before finishing with a good surge in last impressive win from this post when making first start in nearly six months. He broke very slow two outs ago and needs alert start at this distance.

ONE BOLDASIOUS SECRET - Finished .25 behind rival Cee The Leader in last seventh-place showing and lacked rally two outs ago when sixth vs. eventual starter allowance \$6,250 runnerup Countin Coronas. He lost nose photo at this distance three races back.

SARAS SIX PAC - Has run strong past races at tonight's 220-yard distance and has been freshened for seven weeks since last seventh-place showing. He was second in solid time at this distance five outs ago when facing recent \$12,500 third-place finisher The Willie Way. He defeated eventual starter allowance \$8,000 runnerup Reloaded at this distance four races back.

CEE THE LEADER - Gets a good post switch and was fifth vs. recent deadheat \$6,250 winner Juno Dat Royal Honor in last outing when making first start in more than two months. He broke slow when fourth vs. stronger two races back and showed early quickness in two wins here last fall. He has solid rider up.

LDS HEZA STREAKER - Adds the flipping halter tonight. He was fractious in the gate before last sixth-place showing vs. rapid winner at this distance and drops in class tonight. Two outs ago, he broke slow and stumbled early when bothered from both sides early. He was third vs. eventual \$16,000 runnerup Vox three outs ago.

CORONAS WAY - Broke extremely slow in comeback outing to ignore. He was fourth vs. eventual starter allowance \$5,000 winner Cee the Leader two races back and won from the extreme outside post nine outs ago. He has winning connections.

Race Analysis

DEVONS AFFAIR - Scrambled away in his hind quarters, was urged at intervals to the 1/16-pole and went evenly late when outworked (12.4-12.5) on March 15. On March 24, he broke well and bobbed before coming under solid urging past the 1/16-pole to outwork rival by a nose.

GOLD LEADER - Broke fast and lugged out throughout while under a fairly good hold late when getting outworked by a head vs. rival MB Time For Corona on March 17. He since worked at Dixie Downs in Utah on March 28.

SUNDOWNER SPECIAL - Broke okay, veered inward early and was under a big hold the final 1/16 while showing nice run to outwork rival (12.5-12.6) in good March 21 drill. On April 3, he broke fast, lugged in mildly early and was ridden past the 1/16-pole while getting outworked (12.4-12.5) by rival Carters Cartel.

HAWKINS LOVE - Scrambled out and was bumped at the start of March 15 drill before showing good run while under a big hold the final 1/16 when outworking foe (12.5-12.7) in sharp work. On March 31, he stumbled solidly at the start before lugging out while hard to ride the first 1/16. He then lugged in sharply and was under a hold late when outworked (12.3-12.5) in better-than-looked drill.

MY JESS PERRY - Had troubled start in Louisiana debut five weeks ago when facing sharp winner who since captured the \$423,203 futurity finals. On March 24, filly veered out early and lugged out throughout when getting outworked (13.0-13.1). She benefits by race experience.

MB TIME FOR CORONA - Worked in Utah since local March 17 drill when she came away slow and lugged out the final 1/16 when outworking rival Gold Leader by a head.

DEBS SPECIAL - Scrambled in at the start and was asked at intervals when outworking rival by a head on March 24. On March 31, he broke well and went smooth the final 1/16 while under a hand ride to outwork foe (12.5-12.8).

CASH THIS OKIE - Broke slow and finished nicely under a hand ride the final 1/16 when best (12.7-12.8) on March 15. On March 30, he was very quick early and responded when urged once past the 1/16-pole before moving strong late while well in hand when best (12.2-12.8) in solid drill.

CARTERS CARTEL - Broke okay, drifted in mildly early and went very easy the final 1/16 while best (12.5-12.6) in nice March 21 drill. On April 3, he broke slow, drifted in early and went easily while showing run the final 1/16 when best (12.4-12.5). He has top connections.

Race Analysis

SUDDEN PROUD DASH - Needs to improve upon last pair. Three outs ago, he was bumped in soon after the start before angling to the far outside. Gelding needs alert start from this post.

MOOLAHS LAST ONE - Makes his career debut and recorded a slow 350-yard gate drill when working alone on March 28. His prior 220-yard work of 12.7 was a turn and work (not from the gate).

PLANTING CZECH - Shortens up 40 yards and was well clear of the third horse at shorter distance two races back when facing prior maiden \$2,500 runnerup Mighty Big Splash. Three outs ago, he broke slow and was bumped hard at the start. He looms dangerous vs. this easy maiden group.

DESERTS PREFERREDONE - Is one of two class droppers in this field. He was seventh in last start vs. prior maiden \$6,250 third-place finisher and prior maiden \$5,000 runnerup Cleats R. Flying. He never threatened in debut at shorter distance when facing runnerup Luva Bono, who since won for maiden \$4,000.

SLR SONORAN GAL - Veered inward early to bump a rival in last well-beaten outing at higher level. She veered in and was bumped at the start of prior third-place try at this level when no match for rival Planting Czech. She adds the flipping halter and takes blinkers off.

REDS FLYIN - Showed ability in third-place debut at longer distance when facing first two finishers dropping down from maiden \$5,000 claiming races. Gelding hails from a high-percentage barn and retains strong rider.

IM GOIN BYE BYE - Was improved fourth in second try at longer route in last and lands a favorable post. He was outrun at this distance two races back when facing eventual maiden \$3,200 winner Summer Goods.

EYES DONT LIE - Was lightly bumped early before lugging out in last start at shorter distance. She broke slow two outs back and was sixth three races ago vs. recent \$4,000 winner Bad Ole Boyfriend and eventual maiden \$2,500 winner Im Stuck In Traffic.
