## The Great Charger Bar

Sunday's Grade 1 \$100,000 feature race is named in honor of a true Los Alamitos legend - the great Charger Bar.

No horse has won more stakes races at Los Alamitos than Ed Allred and Kenneth Wright's Charger Bar. The AQHA World Champion in 1971 and a nine-time AQHA Champion during her career, Charger Bar won 18 stakes over the Cypress racing strip, including the second running ever of the Champion of Champions in 1973.

A 1968 foal out of the Rocket Bar mare La Ree Bar and by the stallion Tiny Charger, Charger Bar won the Los Alamitos Invitational Championship in 1971 and then again in 1974. She also won the Los Alamitos Derby in 1971. Wayne Charlton saddled her in each of those victories and Jim Dreyer rode her. Charger Bar won 28 races and earned \$495,437 in her career.

Charger Bar became one of the top broodmares of her time, as the dam of Go Man Go Handicap and Los Alamitos Invitational Championship winner Blushing By, La Primera Del Ano Derby winner Go Proudly and Independence Day Handicap winner Proud Heritage.

Charger Bar is buried in the infield at Los Alamitos Race Course, where a monument near the clubhouse turn honors her legacy.



## CHARGER BAR

Charger Bar was a nine-time AQHA Champion. She was the World Champion, Champion 3-Year-Old Filly and Champion Mare in 1971. She was also the Champion Aged Mare and Champion Mare in '72, '73 and '74.
